Contributing Editor Laura de Gunzburg takes a winter sojourn to Europe, stopping by the season's must-see events and checking in with artists.



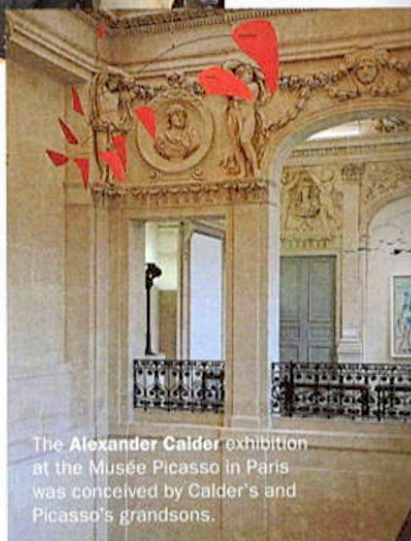
